Show baby how to hold a ball above a bowl in front of her and **drop it** into the bowl. When she has mastered this, can you find a round-bottomed bowl and several balls or rolled-up socks. This is much more difficult because she has to hold the bowl with one hand and place balls in the bowl with the other.

Any baking tins for mince-pies, fairy cakes or muffins will provide a very good **puzzle** for baby. Give her some balls or rolled-up socks and see if she can put them into the holes. You could also use an egg carton.

Make some **shaky toys** out of butter tubs. Place some dried peas/beans/pasta shapes inside, then seal well. Let baby enjoy shaking them.

Get a simple scrap book and stick different pieces of material of different **textures** to each page. For 'quiet time' 'read' the book, turning over the pages slowly and letting baby feel the different textures of each piece of material.
