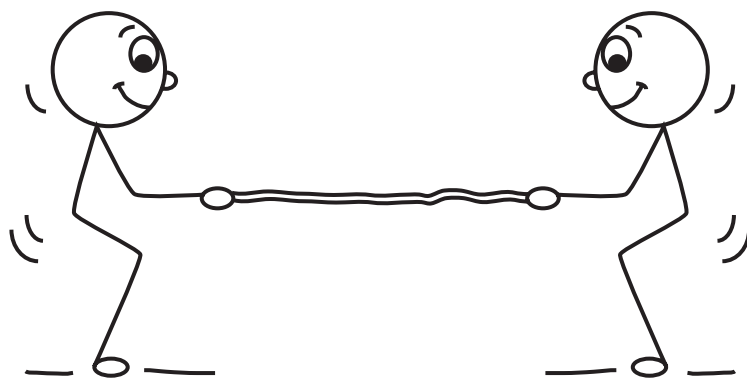


P54 THE WEATHER REPORT

The parachute starts taut and “calm” and everyone decides upon a name for the ocean (e.g. Pacific) and then they move the parachute in response to the “weather report”. e.g. “On my way to work this morning I heard on the weather report that there was a slight breeze over the Pacific Ocean” etc.



P55 MOVING THROUGH THE JUNGLE

Children are numbered 1, 2, 3, or given a coloured band to wear, and as the parachute mushroom is created and rises, the adult calls “No.3 move like a monkey!” and all the number 3’s move across the circle to the other side travelling like monkeys! (*Ask children to suggest different animals in the jungle - e.g. monkeys, tigers, elephants, snakes, parrots etc. and spend some time before the parachute game practising how to move like the different animals.*)
