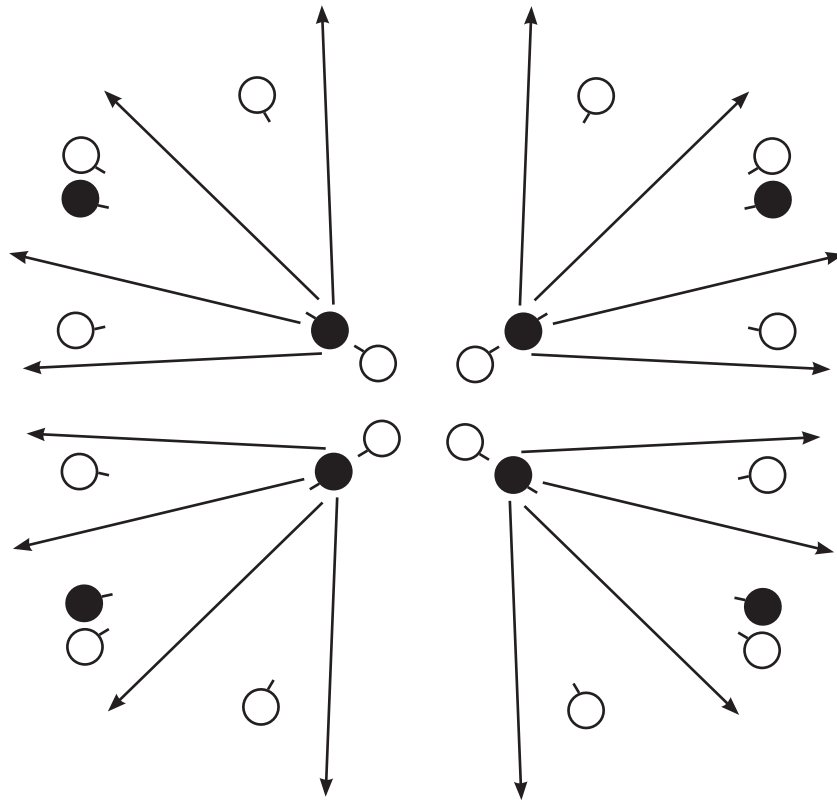


Other playground markings are essential and can be used to advantage - markings such as circles, hopscotch, ladders, wall targets, etc.

(COACHES BE AWARE: Because of the unique nature of striking/fielding games (hitting for position and distance) the SAFETY of children is paramount. Therefore, in practices or small game situations where children are required to strike a ball competitively, the "WHEEL" organisation would be the most appropriate. Similarly for invasion games, this shape is effective for practising penalty shots or striking at goal.)



Children are less likely to have accidents with the ball or the bat if they are striking AWAY from the centre of the space into their own arc.

N.B. Whatever the size of the playing space, for safety, a ball should be struck towards the outside edges. When several groups are engaged in any target activity.
